




Fixed Fire Suppression System


- Fixed Fire Suppression System
 \$22 Million dollar
- Completed December 2015
- First fire suppression system retrofitted into an existing tunnel in the US.
- Activated on two fires. More severe of the two was January 28, 2019, and system likely saved the south bore from being shut down for at least a week. Tunnel was reopened within an hour after the event.
- Fire was hot enough to melt lights and damage the wall







- SB 260 identifies \$50M of improvements to the Eisenhower Johnson Complex.
- CDOT's asset
 management system has
 identified approximately
 \$150 M of deferred
 maintenance items on
 the 49 year old facility.






EJMT Drainage, Plumbing, Heat Trace

Scope

- Drainage, Plumbing, and heat trace improvements
- Generator Replacement
- Water Treatment Facility
- 600 HP Fan Motor Rewind (North tunnel fans)
- Contract Method
 - Design/Build

EJMT Plenum Liner

Scope

• Repair and mitigate all Condition State 4 (CS4 - structural review needed) and CS3 (poor condition) in both tunnel bores to mitigate water intrusion within the tunnel plenum liner.









EJMT Grout Bed

Scope

 Replace/ repair grout beds that support wall panels and address/ repair steel hangar issues







EJMT Service Area Repair

Scope

- Replace fire extinguisher cabinets
- Service area improvements to repair guardrail, surface drainage, asphalt, pavement markings, tunnel portal brick repair, etc.
- Install new automated portal deicing system
- Tunnel Sensor upgrades for safety enhancements to include: LiDAR over height sensor, thermal imaging for overheated engines, and hazardous placard identifier





Public Hearings | Greenhouse Gas Pollution Reduction:

The <u>Transportation Commission of Colorado</u> and Colorado Department of Transportation are proposing a new standard to reduce greenhouse gas emissions from the transportation sector, improve air quality and reduce smog, and provide more travel options. CDOT, on behalf of the Commission, will hold eight public hearings across the state to provide opportunities for public comment on this new proposed standard. These hearings will be held in-person and virtually, with Spanish interpretation available. Individuals are encouraged to attend a public hearing and submit written comments to <u>dot_rules@state.co.us</u>.
